Summary Statement:

Background:

The CDBG Grant application process requires the City of Woodland to conduct public hearings to receive input on prospective projects. There will be two public hearings. One on 10/21 and one on 11/4. Tonight's hearing focuses on receiving input on possible projects. Staff will then review the suggestions from tonight and provide some recommendations for the 11/4 public hearing. Council will then vote on what project to apply for after the 11/4 public hearing.

In Woodland, the CDBG eligible area is generally west of I-5 in the older part of town. One exception to that are ADA projects which are eligible anywhere. Eligible projects include water improvements, sewer improvements, sidewalks, paths, etc. Previous Woodland CDBG projects include sidewalk improvements and the City Hall Elevator.

Last year the City applied for funding of a paved accessible path around Horseshoe Lake Park. The City is currently expecting to receive at least \$50,000 in grant funds for this project and the proposed 2014 budget proposes using those funds and a City match to construct that project next year.
