Dear Mari,

We wish to express our appreciation for the city's funding during 2013. Since we are required to raise funds from the communities we serve as matches for CAP's various state and federal grants, your annual contribution is deeply appreciated.

For your information, here is a summary of some of the services CAP has provided to the Woodland Community during 2013:

-1800 meals were served to homebound seniors through the Meals on Wheels program.

-1529 hot meals were served through the weekly Senior Community Lunch Program at St. Phillip's Catholic Church.

-CAP's I-5 Van service provided 6300 rides at an average of 631 pick-ups and drop-offs per month. This rural public transportation service carried Woodland residents as far north as Castle Rock, and as far south as the 99th Street Transit center in Vancouver.

-CAP's Senior Transportation service has provided 88 rides for seniors at the Woodside Terrace apartments to the Woodland Walmart this year. In addition, 30 trips have been provided to seniors from Woodland to medical appointments in the Vancouver/Portland area.

We thank you for the opportunity to serve this great community and your consideration of these services as you prepare next year's budget.
