**A. Lake Update.** Discussion was held regarding lake levels, updates from the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife, nets seen in the lake, fly fishing, cormorant sightings, and pump run dates.

**B. Water Quality.**

**Centennial Grant** – Discussion ensued regarding testing, buoy placement, volunteer work, using GPS, and equipment sharing.

**IAVMP** – Terry Jones and Bill Dunlap spoke regarding a newly created grid map and boat voyages to chart weed growth. Scott Perry reported that he took updated drone photos and spoke regarding color variations related to milfoil growth. Tom Golik presented handouts of King County’s Plan, Devils Lake data, milfoil management methods, etc. and gave copies to Mr. Dunlap. Jody Bartkowski spoke regarding permitting for grass carp. Mike Curry gave a report on chemical application and permitting. Pat Rychel volunteered to do work on water body identification and watershed features.

Additional discussion was held regarding site visits, data recording methods, sampling methods, drone photos, water depth, camera viewing, and creation of an extension rod for the Secchi Disk.


