CONTINUED BUSINESS

A. Lake Update. Chairman Golik presented an email from Mike London at the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) regarding the pump status and an email from Stacie Kelsey regarding outlet structure repairs and fish counts.

Discussion ensued regarding pump readings, recent Lake levels, fuel drippings on South Pekin, and drainage on Fifth Street, South Pekin, and I-5 along Lakeshore Drive.

B. Water Quality.

Integrated Aquatic Vegetation Management Plan (IAVMP). Committee Member Dunlap reported that he and Terry Jones used a camera to record the Lake bottom at the four test buoy sites and submitted a fact sheet with still photos. Discussion ensued regarding weed growth, testing dates, and volunteering.

Open conversation was held regarding work at Devil's Lake, different types of milfoil, methods for combating milfoil, focusing on grass carp, grass carp diets, studies at Sawyer Lake in King County, the use of weevils, studies possibly done by Central Washington University, and progress at Blue Lake.

Further discussion ensued regarding the next steps to take, who will be doing what, gathering data, creating a final project, involving the public, and involvement by other agencies.



ADJOURNMENT


