City of Woodland – Police Station Site Development

Application for coverage under Construction Stormwater NPDES permit

City of Woodland, P.O. Box 9 Woodland, WA 98674, is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit. The proposed project, Woodland Police Station is located adjacent to the northwest corner of Scott Avenue and Old Pacific Highway, Woodland, Washington, in Cowlitz County. This project involves 1.4 acres of soil disturbance for police station building and parking construction activities. Stormwater will be discharged to a tributary to Burris Creek.

Any persons desiring to present their views to the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding this application, or interested in Ecology's action on this application, may notify Ecology in writing no later than 30 days of the last date of publication of this notice. Ecology reviews public comments and considers whether discharges from this project would cause a measurable change in receiving water quality, and, if so, whether the project is necessary and in the overriding public interest according to Tier II antidegradation requirements under WAC 173-201A-320.
