ORDINANCE NO. 1147

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WMC 5.12.030(B) TO AUTHORIZE SETTING LICENSE FEES BY RESOLUTION FOR PUBLIC DANCES AND JUVENILE DANCES AND APPROVING AN ORDINANCE SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION AS MORE PARTICULARLY SET FORTH HEREIN

Recitals

WHEREAS, the City of Woodland has adopted ordinances for the purposes of setting similar license fees by resolution rather than ordinance, finding an amended resolution can effect and prefer*** policy alternative to individual ordinances;

AND, WHEREAS, the license fees for public dances is set by ordinance and shall be set by resolution.

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Woodland as follows:

Section 1. Old Section 5.12.030(B): The existing ordinance is as follows:

B. License Fees.

1. No license fee shall be required for a private dance or a school dance.
2. A license fee of ten dollars per quarter shall be paid by each person, organization, or group conducting a juvenile dance or dances. The license is not transferable, and the licensee is not limited as to the number of such dances to be held during a calendar quarter.
3. All persons or organizations conducting a public dance shall pay a fee of five dollars for each dance for which a license is obtained, except for dances held on premises licensed to sell intoxicating beverages by the state.
4. Any establishment licensed by the state to sell alcoholic beverages and conduct dances shall pay an annual license fee of fifty dollars if no charge is made or gratuity accepted for admission to any dance, and if a charge is made or a gratuity given for admission to any dance conducted at any such establishment, the fee for each such dance shall be the sum of five dollars.

Section 2. New Section WMC 5.12.030(B): WMC 5.12.030(B) is amended and the following language is new section WMC 5.12.030(B):

B. License Fees.

1. No license fee shall be required for a private dance or school dance.

2. A license fee, as established by resolution, shall be paid by each person, organization, or group conducting a juvenile dance or dances. The license is not transferable, and the licensee is not limited as to the number of such dances to be held during a calendar quarter.

3. All persons or organizations conducting a public dance shall pay a license fee, as established by resolution for each dance for which a license is obtained, except for dances held on premises licensed to sell intoxicating beverages by the state.

4. Any establishment licensed by the State to sell alcoholic beverages and conduct dances shall pay a license fee as established by resolution.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.




**SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 1147
