

**ORDINANCE NO. 1160**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF WOODLAND ORDINANCE 368, CODIFIED AS WMC 10.40.070, REGARDING THE REGULATIONS OF MERCHANDISE FOR SALE ON STREETS AND SIDEWALKS.**

**Recitals**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds the recommendation of the city staff is to modify current regulations regarding merchandise for sale on streets and sidewalks is in the best interest of the City of Woodland and its citizens.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLAND, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Amended Section. Woodland Municipal Code Section 10.40.070 is hereby amended as follows:

**EXISTING**

**Existing Woodland Municipal Code 10.40.070:**

**WMC 10.40.070 - Merchandise for sale on streets and sidewalks.**

It is unlawful for any person to store or display any goods, wares or merchandise, or any other article or thing for purposes of sale or otherwise on any street, right-of-way, alley or sidewalk, or in the space between the sidewalk and street curbs in the city; provided, however, this section shall not be construed to prevent the holding of an annual merchandise fair upon the streets and sidewalk of the city with the time, place, exhibitors and exhibits to be fixed by resolution of the city council. (Ord. 368 § 1-41, 1973)

**PROPOSED**

**Proposed Woodland Municipal Code 10.40.070:**

**WMC 10.40.070 - Merchandise for sale on streets and sidewalks.**

It is unlawful for any person to store or display any goods, wares or merchandise, or any other article or thing for purposes of sale or otherwise on any street, right-of-way, alley or sidewalk, or in the space between the sidewalk and street curbs in the city; provided, however, this section shall not be construed to prevent the holding of *a Farmer's Market* or annual merchandise fair upon the streets and sidewalk of the city with the time, place, exhibitors and exhibits to be fixed by resolution of the city council. (Ord. 368 § 1-41, 1973)


**Section 2.** Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or constitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

**Section 3.** Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective five (5) days after publication.






**SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 1160**
