RESOLUTION NO. 581

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE THIRTY-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF WOODLAND MOBILE MEALS, A NON-PROFIT COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION AND EXPRESSING THE CITY'S APPRECIATION FOR THE WORK OF PAST AND PRESENT VOLUNTEERS AND FOR THE FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE COMMUNITY

Recitals

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1979, three decades ago, a group of Woodland citizens took the initiative to create Woodland Mobile Meals, a non-profit corporation, for the sole purpose of providing meals every weekday to the house-bound and to those who are unable to prepare a meal for themselves;

WHEREAS, local volunteers have maintained this commitment to their neighbors for thirty years, without Federal, State or Local funding. One hundred percent of every dollar donated to Woodland Mobile Meals, is spent on food. Volunteers not only give of their time and energy but contribute transportation, fuel and office supplies without subsidy;

WHEREAS, these efforts contribute to the overall well-being of the greater Woodland community and their actions underscore that in Woodland independent community spirit remains alive, spanning generations and crossing all walks of life and that in Woodland being a neighbor is more than a phrase.

AND WHEREAS, the City believes it to be both just and proper to recognize Woodland Mobile Meals long term community commitment on this 30 year anniversary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLAND AS FOLLOWS:






