

RESOLUTION NO. 591

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Woodland establishing certain rates, charges and fees relating to the city’s sewer service and rate schedule for low income senior citizens and low income disabled persons.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 798 provides that rates, charges and fees relating to the city’s sewer service will be established by resolution of the city council and pursuant thereto the city council adopted Resolution No. 428 establishing such rates and fees for sewer service and rate schedule for low income senior citizens and low income disabled persons; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 571 which repealed Resolution No. 475 and 428 which provided for a rate increase on February 16, 2009 and further modifications in the future; and

WHEREAS, following a duly advertised public hearing held on November 1, 2010 the city council directed staff to prepare documents modifying sewer rates from those established in Resolution No. 571 as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLAND that the following rates, charges and fees applicable to the city’s sewer service and charges and fees relating to the city’s sewer service and rate schedule for low income senior citizens and low income disabled persons be and hereby are fixed and imposed, effective December 16, 2010.

A. Sewer Service Rates and Charges (Chapter 13.08):

(1) Sewer Assessment Charges (WMC 13.08.030):

(4) Sewer rates for Monthly Service (WMC 13.08.070) **effective December 16, 2010** [billed 02/25/2011 with revenue collected beginning March, 2011]:

a. Residential (Single Family-one meter per residence)-- Bi Monthly Base Charge \$35.55

e. Suspended Solids - to be determined by Public Works Director

f. Discount on the basic residential rate charged for residential use for qualifying low income senior citizen or low income disabled person (WMC 13.08.140):

- e. Suspended Solids - to be determined by Public Works Director
- f. Discount on the basic residential rate charged for residential use for qualifying low income senior citizen or low income disabled person (WMC 13.08.140):



C. All Bi-Monthly sewer base meter charges and Unit Charge hcf* shall be increased seven percent (7%) annually on December 16th of each subsequent year.


D. At such time as the new rates take effect, the rates set forth in Resolution No. 571 shall be null and void.


