WHEREAS, the City of Woodland recognizes that Woodland schools are all over crowded and in need of support from all entities in the community to pass an upcoming bond; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Woodland can support the schools by passing this resolution,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Woodland do ordain as follows:




